Test Name	Synonyms	Panels	Clinical Significance
Lactate Dehydrogenase	LDH, LD		This test is used to help detect a condition causing tissue damage, such as a blood or liver disease, and to monitor its progress, and to help stage, determine prognosis, and/or response to treatment of certain cancers
Lipase	LPS		This test is used to diagnose and monitor acute pancreatitis. It is also sometimes used to diagnose and monitor chronic pancreatitis or other pancreatic diseases.
Low Density Lipoprotein, Calculated	LDL-C	Lipid Panel	This test is calculated using Total Cholesterol, HDL, and Triglycerides. This test is used to assess your risk of developing heart disease and to monitor the effectiveness of lipid-lowering therapy
