Test Name	Synonyms	Panels	Clinical Significance
Hematocrit	Hct, Crit, Packed Cell Volume, PCV, H and H (Hemoglobin and Hematocrit)	vCBC, vCBCD	This test is used to determine the proportion of blood that is made up of red cells (RBCs) in order to screen for, help diagnose, or monitor conditions that affect RBCs.
Hemoglobin	Hgb, Hb, H and H (Hemoglobin and Hematocrit)	vCBC, vCBCD	This test is used to evaluate the hemoglobin content of blood to screen for and diagnose conditions that affect red blood cells (RBCs), and to assess the severity of anemia or polycythemia and monitor response to treatment.
High Density Lipoprotein	HDL	Vet Lipid Panel	HDL can be used to assess the risk of developing heart disease.
