Test Name	Synonyms	Panels	Clinical Significance
Uric Acid	UA, Serum Urate		This test is used to help diagnose the condition of gout and to monitor uric acid levels when undergoing chemotherapy or radiation treatment.
Urinalysis			This test is used to screen for, help diagnose, and monitor several diseases and conditions, such as kidney disorders or urinary tract infections (UTIs)
Urine Culture and Sensitivity			This test is used to identify bacteria that may be causing a urinary tract infection (UTI) and the antibiotics that may be used to treat the UTI.
Urine for Eosinophils			This test is used to detect eosinophils (a type of white blood cell) in the urine that may be present in cases of acute interstitial nephritis, which is caused by an allergic reaction (typically to medications or other drugs)
Urine Microscopic			This test is used to screen for, help diagnose, and monitor several diseases and conditions, such as kidney disorders or urinary tract infections (UTIs)
